

**ART****Bassett Artist To Exhibit Work At BC**

Artist Ed Dolinger of Bassett will exhibit two and three-dimensional works from Oct. 3 through Nov. 2 in the Cleo Driver Miller Art Gallery at Bridgewater College. The show, "Line of Thought," follows decades of studio work that has drawn Dolinger into the exploration of "line" in both mixed-media paintings and welded steel sculpture.

Currently a full-time artist, Dolinger has been an adjunct faculty member at Hollins University and Sweet Briar College. He has served as gallery director at Riverviews Artspace and curator of exhibitions at Lynchburg Fine Arts Center, both in Lynchburg. A 2010 recipient of a fellowship from the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts, Dolinger has also participated in numerous exhibitions at national, state and regional venues.

His work can be found in public and private collections around the country.

An artist's reception will be held from 5-7 p. m. Oct. 3, with an artist's talk at 5:30 p. m. Both events will be in the Miller Art Gallery.

The talk, reception and exhibition are open to the public at no charge.

The Miller Gallery, located on the second floor of the Alexander Mack Memorial Library, is open 8 a. m.- midnight Monday- Thursday, 9 a. m.- 5 p. m. Friday and Saturday and 1- 11 p. m. Sunday.
